## ‘The fair has always been close to my heart’

*Waukesha County Fair marshal explains his history with the fair*

WAUKESHA — As the Waukesha County Fair approaches, Fair Marshal Robert Stigler reminisces on his experiences at the fair. Stigler said he serves as an ambassador for the Waukesha County Fair and takes pride in reminding everyone how fun and important the fair is to the Waukesha community.

His lifetime commitment to the fair has led him to become the fair marshal.

Stigler's involvement started when he was a young boy and his mother was a part of the original committees that organized the fair.

Growing up, Stigler sold tickets and participated in almost every committee himself. When he started having children of his own, he took them to the fair and they became involved with the 4-H programs.

Eventually, many people started to notice his dedication and love for the fair, so he was elected to the Waukesha County Fair Board in 1989. He then served as the vice president for 14 years and as president for two years.

Now, his legacy continues as his children are invested in the fair and have been a part of the Waukesha County Fair Board, too. Stigler said he considers being involved

# Waukesha County Fair to display Drone Light Show

WAUKESHA — Waukesha County’s night sky will be lit up with drones dancing to patriotic songs and popular tunes on Wednesday, July 17 and Thursday, July 18.

On opening night, the Waukesha County Fair will be premiering the Drone Light Show put on by the Great Lakes Drone Company. This fair will be the first in Wisconsin to put on a drone show, according to Waukesha County Fair Executive Director Chrissy Gluege.

The fair’s website explains how 25 drones will light up the sky with a choreographed performance 200 feet above the fairgrounds at 8:45 p.m. Wednesday and 10 p.m. Thursday after the Main Stage performance.

On both evenings, those in the audience will have a chance to meet and greet the pilots behind the dancing drones.

Great Lakes Drone Company is a Michigan-based company that utilizes the latest UAV technology to bring high quality imagery and data through drones. This company has worked with the Michigan State Fair, SeaWorld and partners with Toyota and Ford.

Now, the Great Lakes Drone Company will be working with the Waukesha County Fair to bring Wisconsin’s first fair drone
