

Book vending machine comes to Dixon Elementary

Students can select a book for their birthday

BROOKFIELD — Dixon Elementary welcomed students back to school this vear with a "book vending machine," allowing students to get a new book on their birthdays.

Sara Monty, Dixon Elementary library assistant, PTO co-president and Dixon parent, said some students got the chance to use the book vending machine on the first day of school.

"We made the first day of school quite exciting because there were a few kids who had birthdays,' Monty said.

The machine, an Inchy's Bookworm Book Vending Machine sold by Global Vending Group based in Buffalo, NY, doesn't run on money, but on tokens, Monty said.

"They're a little golden coin that has a bookworm on it," she said. "(Students) put the token in, and then it's just like a normal vending machine."

For now, students can only use the vending machine on their birthdays, when they will receive a bookworm token from the front office. Students with summer birthdays will get their token on their half-birthday. Monty said vending machine use could expand to incentives for things like good behavior or achieving academic goals, but the Dixon PTO decided to start with birthdays so every student can be included and have the chance to use the book vending machine.

"It was really important to us that every student got one just for being a student at Dixon," Monty said in a statement. "By providing every student with a

book on their birthday, we are conveying the message that every child's education journey is valuable."

The vending machine currently holds 20 different books with multiple copies of each. Books appropriate for each grade level at Dixon are included, from picture books to lengthier chapter books.

Students and parents alike have given positive responses to the vending machine. "The parent response

was so excited and very enthusiastic about it," Monty said. "(The students are) so excited when they come and get their token."

Parents in the community are excited for the opportunity to foster a love of reading, Monty said.

'We're all real excited about it and about the opportunities, and hopefully some other schools in the area might do the same thing, and we'll get all of Waukesha and Brookfield loving reading books."




